### **Important Information**

- Children <u>must</u> be eligible for the Federal Vaccine for Children program. The child must be either (a) have Medicaid or All Kids, (b) be American Indian or Alaskan Native, (c) be totally uninsured, or (d) have insurance that does not cover their immunizations.
- The only shots given to children who are not VFC eligible are flu shots.
- If a parent cannot accompany their child to the clinic, they must provide a <u>written note</u> allowing another adult to consent to the child's vaccinations.
- An adult must remain with children under 18 years old at all times
- Immunization Records are <u>required</u> at all clinics please bring your child's records.
- If the school has sent any immunization papers home, please bring those along with your child's records
- Children's Shots are \$16.00 each. Children will not be denied services based on ability to pay.
- To get a replacement for a lost immunization record, please bring a valid ID. The fee is \$2.00 per lost record.
- We take Medicaid. Medicare Part B. All Kids. cash. checks. and credit cards.
